

BARKEYVILLE BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Barkeyville Borough Council met on May 3, 2005 at 7:00pm. in the Borough building.

President Leanne Stearns called the meeting to order. Mayor Mary Rose led in the pledge to the American flag.

ROLL CALL: Present were: Mayor Mary Rose, President Leanne Stearns, Council members: Warren Whetzel, Alvin Patton, Regis Brick II, Wallace Stearns, Charlie Nolf, Jeff McConnell, Treasurer, Secretary.

GUESTS: Bob Black, Gary Dovey, George and Mary Ann Dellich, Joe Pacchioni, Jeff Breitenstein, Jim Courson, Amy Ski, Attorney Martin, Cindy Linnin, Glenn Cochran.

OPENING OF PARK BIDS:

#1. Clearwater Construction of Mercer, PA. with a bid of \$27,966.00.

#2. Bill Dellich Excavating of West Sunbury, PA. with a bid of \$34,503.00.

Alvin Patton made the motion to table bids until Neil Parks has a chance to review them. Warren Whetzel seconded it. Vote unanimous.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: Cindy Linnin and Glenn Cochran from the Oil Regional Alliance addressed Council. Ms. Linnin stated that the utilities are going in at the Industrial Park. She also stated that there is interest in the site. They may put a sign on the water tower to identify the Industrial Park.

Mr. Cochran stated that a major problem is getting natural gas to the park. Mr. Cochran stated they are speaking with several companies to get that service. Mr. Cochran also stated they may go ahead and construct a building themselves on the property to jump start the park to market and sell.

Amy Ski addressed Council about the upcoming Community Day in Clintonville. Ms. Ski asked Council to consider nominating an outstanding citizen in the community for recognition at a ceremony to be held at the Community Day. Miss Ski also requested a \$100.00 donation.

Mr. Jeff Breitenstein addressed Council. Mr. Breitenstein stated that he had mailed a letter to Council outlining his plans for his property. Secretary read letter to Council at this time. Joe Pacchioni spoke of sewage requirements and different options concerning sewage service to the area. Mr. Pacchioni stated that at next month's meeting he would present to Council a summary of the DEP plan.

Warren Whetzel made the motion to accept Jeff Breitenstein's proposal for sewage pending passing the dye test. Wallace Stearns seconded it. Vote unanimous.

President Leanne Stearns stated they she has received two requests for certificates of occupancy.
